Distinguished Taste

When we planted our first vines we named our vineyard Rain Dance, the same as our wine label. As we've grown and established more vineyards, each has been given a name which depicts its story and nuances (Foothills, Grand Oak, Lee's). In 2019 we decided it was time to give our namesake vineyard a more descriptive name and label, thus, we introduce:

Eagles Watch Vineyard

In the spring of 2009, under the watchful eye of resident eagles, the first of our vines were planted among the gentle slopes and luscious forest of the southern ridge of the Chehalem Mountains.

Not shy out of the bottle, the 2019 Eagles Watch is sporting dark cherry and raspberry flavors with a hint of blood orange citrus. Plush, round tannins lead into complex layer of blackberry fruit flavors that eventually move into a long, lasting finish that leaves you wanting for more. It is certainly approachable now with a light decanting but will reward with patience in the cellar.
